**Do you enjoy practical work outdoors?**

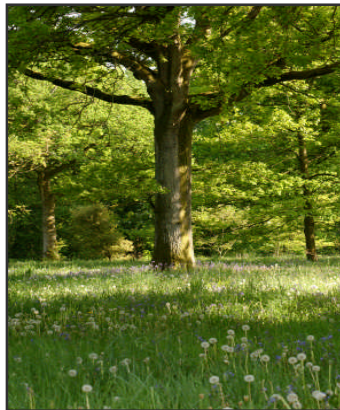
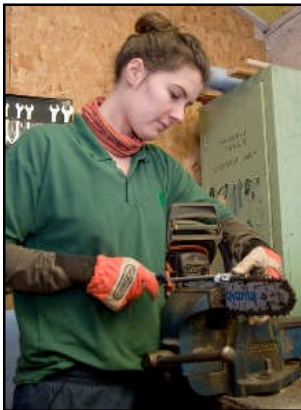
**Are you interested in starting a rewarding career in forestry or countryside management?**
